



In her early twenties Hazel moved to Edmonton, where she got a job with Canadian Utilities. While working there she made many friends who introduced her to the love of her life, Bill Dandeneau. They married in 1962 and moved into their brand new home where they lived for 50 years. They befriended their neighbours and adopted the neighbourhood children; having a lifelong relationship with many of them.

Friends, Bob & Marlene Van Loo introduced Bill & Hazel to square dancing in 1990. Since then they have traveled and danced throughout Canada, U.S.A. and Europe. They danced with the Whirlaways square dance club, the Kensington Strollers round dance club, and the Sherbrook Shuffling 8's square dance club. At the Whirlaways' annual campout, Hazel always had a special treat for those campers who came Friday night. Bill and Hazel would come early Friday help set things up, greet each camper, give them a special handmade gift, and then they would get in their car and drive to the Friday night football game. 
Hazel was a happy fun-loving, creative person. We'll miss you Hazel. Thanks for the memories!

Joyce Victoria Hill was born on the family homestead near Pickardville, Alberta on November 19, 1929, to parents Robert and Victoria Hill and little sister to Doris.

Throughout her life, Joyce was always proud of her rural roots. Whether horseback riding, raising turkeys, driving tractor or gardening, she recognized the value of making use of what you have and being prepared for the unexpected.

In May, 1945 the family sold the farm and moved to Edmonton where Joyce attended Commercial High School. In 1949 Joyce enrolled in a training program at Naramata Christian Leadership Training Center. It was here that she established so many cherished life-long friendships. The summer of 1950 saw her working at a United Church's summer hospital at Rivers Inlet and a hostel in Bella Bella, BC.

Upon returning to Edmonton, Joyce took a job at the U of A Hospital Payroll Office. Shortly thereafter she met Jack at an Interdenominational Young People's event. They married on June 8, 1953 at McDougall United Church and honey-mooned in Ontario visiting relatives on both sides.

They took up residence on the University Farm where they lived until Jack's retirement in 1992. Joyce worked at the Payroll Office until starting their family. Dale was born in 1955 and Ila in 1957. She managed a well-organized but welcoming home, always with more food in the garden or pantry.

Joyce will be remembered for her kindness, dedication, organization skills, and willingness to help where ever needed.


Even though her parents spoke Polish, she was only allowed to speak English. She attended Iron Creek School, Batt School and graduated from Irma High School. During her childhood she worked on the family farm. Her 1<sup>st</sup> paying job was working in the bank, splitting her days between Irma and Wainwright. When she started to work there, she did not even know what a cheque was, and she was not very familiar with cash either (as children they did not receive any money).

In 1954 she married Stuart Helfrich and together they had 8 children. Now she has 21 grand-children & 4 great grandchildren. She started square dancing in 1983 at the Edmonton Single Squares where she met Dave Patterson. They started dating March 1985 and were married July 24, 1987. It was Dave's 1<sup>st</sup> marriage because he was waiting to get it right.

When she started going out with Dave she realized she needed to learn Round Dancing. She was already a good dancer so it was not that difficult. During the spring and summer of 1985 they attended social dances where Dave cued for her as they danced and she learned the basics (Dave had already been teaching and cuing). In Sept. 1985 she became Dave's round dance partner and for several years they instructed classes at Red's Rounders and at the Community Dance Program. She also danced at Lukes and Lucys with caller Wayne Russell, as Dave cued the rounds, and with the Linseeds with caller Clem Nadon.

Over the years she helped to organize many BBQs & campouts for the Edmonton Single Squares and for Red's Rounders. Over the years she has held various positions on many boards. In 1990 she became an "Honorary Member" of the Kleen Air Social Club for serving on the board for 10 years. She continued to serve on the board for more than 30 years, holding various positions.
