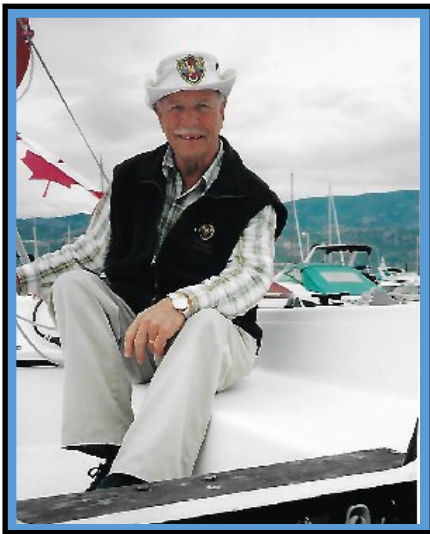

I've since met up with Roger Miller, a dear friend of many years and we are still dancing and enjoying it very much.



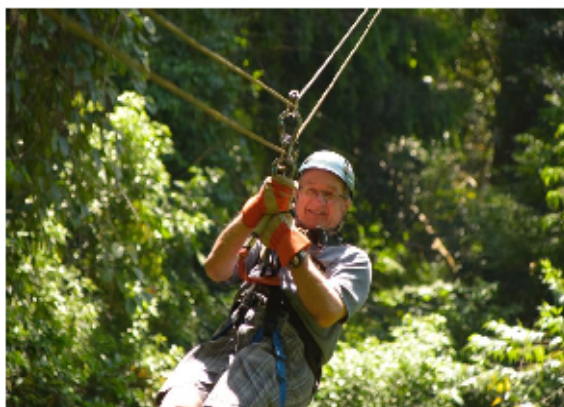
Don Morrison

He had a passion for chemistry and attended the U of A for two years in that faculty, but wanted a more practical involvement so completed a course in Industrial Laboratory Technology at SAIT. Nuclear energy was then all the rage so he took a job with Atomic Energy of Canada in Chalk River, Ontario where he did radiochemical analyses on both the NRX and NRU reactors. Chalk River was very isolated and after two years he had enough and returned to Edmonton, beginning work with the Alberta Research Council where he assisted in kinetic studies of pyrochemical reactions.
