My stay in Canada was supposed to be only for one year but 60 years later I am proud to say I love living in Edmonton.


Together with my dear husband Andy we raised 3 children, been blessed with 5 grandchildren and 3 great grandsons.




We have been dancing with the Double Diamonds since 2004, and presently still dance every week with our group.

Tom decided to take further education at Musker Engineering Institute in Winnipeg where he studied Mechanical design.

Tom moved to Toronto, and worked at Ontario Department of Highways in the Bridge design section. While working at the department, he met Phyllis Buhler who also worked in the department as a secretary. Their friendship grew into a romance which ended up in marriage. They have 3 sons, 3 granddaughters and one great grandson.

Tom had joined the RCAF Reserve, 400 Squadron where he served for 10 years working as an Aviation Technician and had attained the rank of Warrant Officer. Serving in the Air force, presented him with opportunities to serve at several places in Canada, such as Trenton, Fredericton, and the Arctic, as far north as Pelly Bay, NWT, a U S A, Dew Line Station.

Tom changed jobs and went to work for Canadian Industries Ltd (CIL) as a mechanical draftsman. While working, he attended Ryerson Poly Technical Institute, where he graduated as a Civil Engineering Technologist. Tom worked for the city of Oshawa, Ont. as a Building Inspector.

Tom suffered from Hay fever (allergic to Ragweeds) in the Toronto area, so the doctor recommended that he move away from the area. In 1975 Tom relocated with the family to Edmonton, Alberta. Tom worked for the Alberta Government as a Safety Codes Officer and retired in 1993.

When Phyllis's parents retired from farming in Saskatchewan, in 1980, Tom bought the farm, 3/4 of a section of land near Fort Carlton, Saskatchewan. Tom ran the farm as a joint venture.





Edmonton Alberta Canada March 20, 2020

An open letter regarding COVID-19 and the 2020 Alberta Convention:

In these difficult times, we are all focusing on our health and the health of our loved ones – friends and family alike. And so we should be. You may be wondering, 'What about the **2020 Alberta Convention**, scheduled for Labour Day weekend 2020?' This is the current information that we have:

- 1. The Central Lions Recreation Centre in Edmonton is closed, and it has been closed since March 16th. It was first closed as a City of Edmonton facility, and confirmed as closed this week with the declaration of a 'state of emergency' in Alberta.
- 2. Our convention date is still more than five months away and presently we are still planning to hold a convention; however it is possible that we may have to cancel out of concern for public health, and/or at the direction of public authorities.
- 3. In discussion with the ASRDF (Alberta Square and Round Dance Federation) executive, we have developed a contingency plan, should we have to cancel the 2020 AB Convention. If we have to cancel, <u>Edmonton</u> will host the <u>2021</u> Alberta Convention. All registrations received for the 2020 Alberta Convention, will be applied to a 2021 Alberta Convention, in Edmonton.
- 4. As always watch our webpage for updates. This is the direct link: http://www.communitydance.net/convention2020.html
- 5. <u>So, now you know: you will not lose your registration monies</u>! You can safely register now, at our early registration rates (to April 30, 2020). If the 2020 Alberta Convention proceeds, "Oh boy, are we going to be <u>ready</u> to get back to dancing!!"

If it becomes necessary to cancel the 2020 Alberta Convention, your registration will be applied to the 2021 Alberta Convention.

6. Lastly – please help us promote our convention. Promotional activities were curtailed due to the shortening of the dance season. Talk it up with your friends and fellow dancers. 




