Much time was spent, passing on his tricks, and watching many activities grand & great-grandchildren were involved in. Don & Crissie have relished their life-long friends from Wellington Park & St. Peters 2x4's square dancing. Don remained involved in baseball, working with the Trappers & Cracker Cats until 2006. Until the very last, Don's card shark talents made him the luckiest guy at the table. Lovingly remembered, by his wife of 70 years, Crystal; children Dwayne (Rita), Jacqueline (Chris) and Michelle (Mel); 7 Grandchildren; 5 Great-Grandchildren, 5 Siblings, Extended Family, and Friends. The newlyweds headed for Ontario where Denis worked at Simplicity Washing Machines in Hespeler, which is now part of Cambridge.

A few years later, they went back to Alberta where he worked at Red Deer Motors for a short time and then became Assistant Manager at a motel for a number of years.

He made a gutsy move in 1970, when he took the family with three little ones, the baby was not yet 1, to Ottawa. training for Air Traffic Controller. It was a tough course back then, but he passed with flying colours.

From there, the family went to Calgary, then was transferred to Edmonton, back to Calgary and back to Edmonton. That was where they stayed until Denis retired in 2004.

Denis & Therese took up Square Dancing in 2009 with Wayne Russell and the Country Cousins. They still belong to the club, which, along with the rest of them shut down in 2020. They learned to Round Dance in 2016 with Audrey and Glen Eliasson and the Kensington Strollers. They slowly learned enough to enjoy the dances. Hopefully these clubs will start again soon.

Denis enjoys retirement, loves to be with his children and five granddaughters. He enjoys camping and sitting around campfires at his children's acreages.



'Move 'em on, head 'em up': Using Rawhide and the ukulele to battle pandemic blues

After such a year, it might seem strange to celebrate. But that's what the Edmonton Ukulele Circle did this month, marking one year since they learned to embrace Zoom.

Like many Edmonton residents stuck at home during the pandemic, they've pushed forward and even discovered benefits from the forced switch to new technology. Now they meet every Monday instead of every other week, and they can actually hear each leader sing since all the others mute their mic to play along.

"It's great fun, believe me. Great, great fun," said Cecil Stollings, 87. He joins with his daughter Linda and volunteered to give a demonstration on video. The group has seen other family members join from as far away as the Maritimes. "I'm missing the group—sitting around in the circle, live. I do miss that. But Zoom has really filled the void."

Amy Loewen

Amy is a cultural ambassador and along with her husband Reiner joined our square dance club through the Fast Track Program. She was Edmonton's visual artist delegate to Chengdu, China in 2012 and to Wonju, South Korea in 2003. Between 2004 and 2011, she has conducted numerous art educational tours to Europe and China. Amy was the promotions co-ordinator to initiate a Contemporary Canadian Exhibition for 4 established Alberta artists to tour China in 2004. Amy has exhibited her work across Canada from Quebec to Yukon to B.C.; as well as to New York, Shanghai, Hong Kong and Melbourne.

Amy received a Master of Fine Arts degree from the University of Alberta. She is a member of the Royal Canadian Academy of Arts and was inducted into the City of Edmonton Salute to Excellence Arts & Culture Hall of Fame. Over the past two decades, Amy has dedicated her work to the promotion of peace and human understanding. Many of her works illustrate the integration of her Chinese heritage with western postmodernist art practices. Her large scale rice paper installation "A Peace Project" has been designated as a Cultural Property of Canada.

Source of Wonder - Sparking Divine Reconnection, was a Global On Line event, first broadcast in Nov. 2020. This event was organized by two organizations: the Goi Peace Foundation of Japan and the Club of Budapest of Hungary. They invited 80 speakers from around the world to inspire our global family on ways to address the current challenging world situation. Amy Loewan, as a visual artist, was invited to participate as a speaker to talk about her art. Other presenters include the well known spiritual teacher & meditator Deepak Chopra and Jane Goodall who is famous for her work with the chimpanzees.


