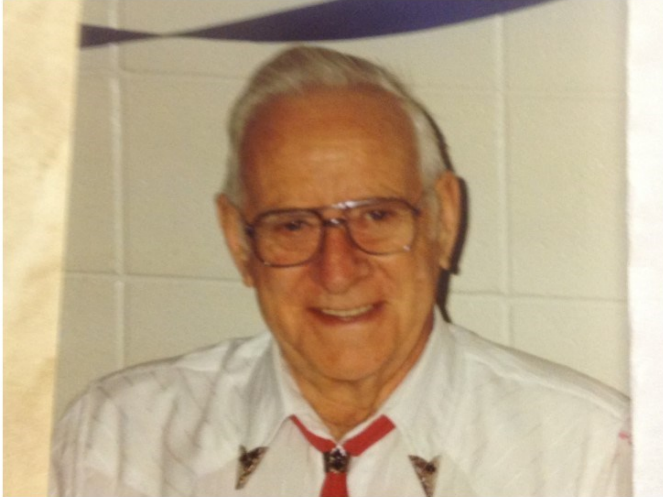
George led a very active life - he worked as a mechanic at the Healy Ford Motor Company for 38 years, was an active member of the Prince of Wales Armoury for 10 years, took up flying in 1997 and was quite proud when he received his pilot's license. He taught Judo at the Jasper Place Judokwai for 12 years, he was an accomplished traveller hiking and fishing with his brother Leonard for many years. He enjoyed dancing, swimming, skiing, and travelling with his wife Sandy. He was very proud of his Icelandic heritage, extensively researching his family roots including a trip with Sandy to Iceland in 1994.

Sandy says 'We started square dancing with Peggy and Al Deby, the Western Stars Club back in 1987 for about 3 to 4 seasons, and then we joined the Groovy Grover for about 6 years, followed by the St. Peter 2X4 in 1996 and then WEP in 2000. George and Doreen Williams did round dancing with the Wildrose Round Dance club for 8 years.

He was an active participant with the West End Seniors walking group and as if that wasn't enough he was also an amateur musician that learned to play by ear (more specifically the spoons, guitar and banjo). Later on, he decided to take up the piano as well.

On behalf of the family we would like to extend a heartfelt thanks to the staff at the Millwoods Grey Nuns Hospital and the Capital Care Grandview Centre for their compassionate care and support during George's stay.





In Loving Memory

George Mayhew

1923—2021

George Mayhew passed away on November 1, 2021 just 3 days before his 98th birthday.

George was born and raised in Edmonton. He lived near the power plant and then attended Eastwood Junior High School. Later he joined the Air Force and was stationed in eastern Canada. He married Elsie Hopwood on January 4, 1945 when he was home on leave. They returned to Edmonton from Gananoque after his discharge, purchased land, built the family home (where Elsie still lives) and then established a business (Avenue Carpet) on 90 street. Many of us have special rugs with the square/round dance symbols that George made and donated as prizes or gifts. Elsie and George started square dancing in 1957 with the Starlites (caller Art Botcher). They also belonged to Beverly Neighbors, Wesley Squares (Fred Faulkner caller), Whirlaways, Tait's Twirlers, Dancalots, Wandering Squares and are honorary/ornery members of Double Diamonds. They have also done their time on ESDA as Vice President and secretary. (To illustrate the type of support they have always given, the Old Faithful bars on their badges would have tripped them if they wore them.) Mayhews have said that square dancing was the best thing they could have added to their lives because of the fun and friendships. They loved their dancing. Fun/mischief was always a big part of George's dancing. He (and Fred, Jim, Dot, Hal, Maurice and Rosalyn) would switch places or squares to test fellow dancers or callers and to make us smile.

George and Elsie also enjoyed their cabin at the lake. George loved his boat, hunting and his motorhomes. Club camp outs and provincial and national conventions were a big part of summers. They even took the first caravan of dancers over the Yellowhead to dance in Vancouver.

Family has always been their first focus. Their daughter Pat and son-in-law Bill worked with them then took over the business but they always worked as a team, George was still binding carpets when he was 92.

Grandchildren Jim and Laurie (Wayne) and great grandchildren Mathew and Cassidy tell how George picked them up after school each day. Unfortunately both Bill and Pat have recently passed away.

The family will miss George dearly as will his dance family.

A long life well lived. Farewell old friend. Thanks for all the good times.

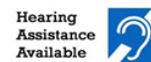

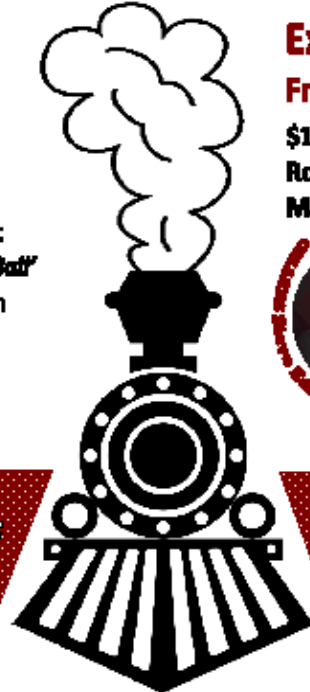

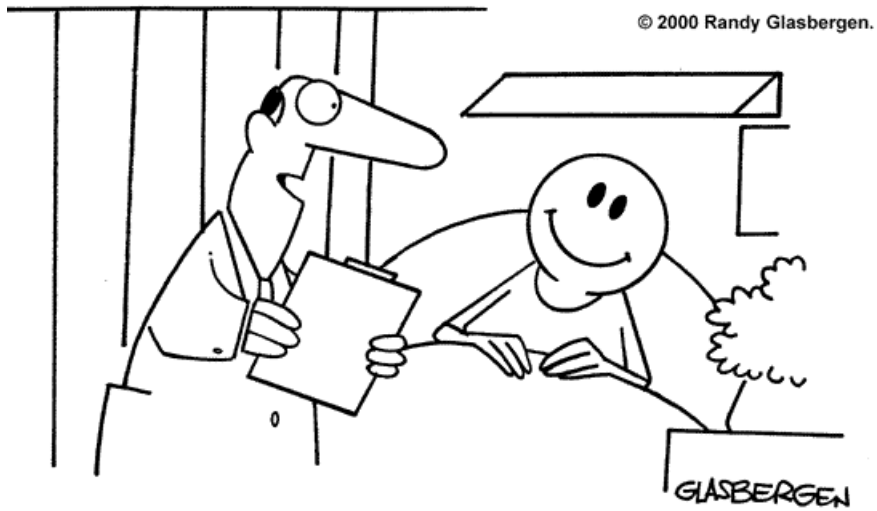

Our callers remain the same - Bob & Ethel Fyfe and Phil & Jo Sedgwick.

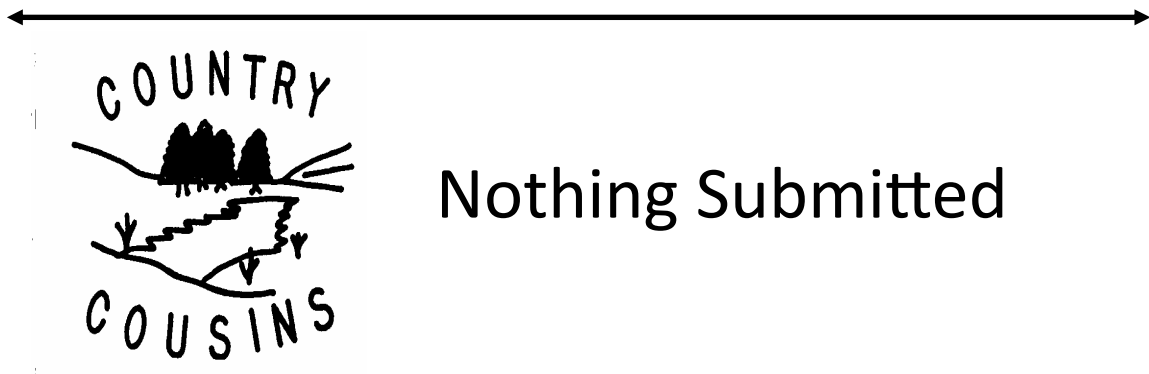
We held our first dance on Nov 5th with one dancer short of two squares (many thanks to our visitors).

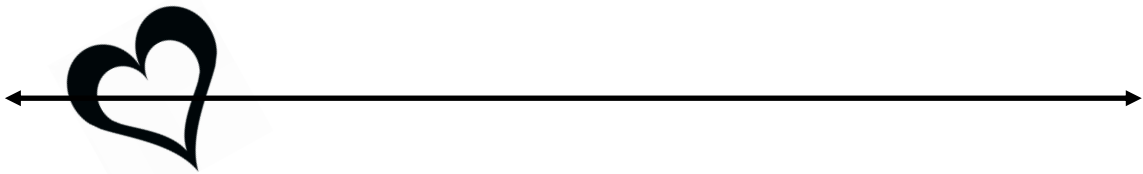

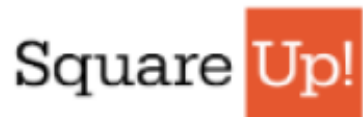

West Edmonton Promenaders says Thanks for the Memories!



Due to a variety of circumstances over the past many months including the pandemic situation, declining club membership in recent years, and other factors, the West Edmonton Promenaders (WEP) met on April 13, 2021 and elected to dissolve the club. It was a sad occasion, but necessary considering the ability to sustain the club.

WEP was founded in 1987. It was the brainchild of Lu Bara and Joanne Kopchia who wanted to bring together a group of friends for something different and new. The club came to life thanks to the founding members who included Lu and Marvin Bara; Norma and Matti Halowski; Jan and Larry Plamondon; Joan and Mike Molden; Joanne and Tony Kopchia; Gina and Bruno Martinello; Wayne and Earline Cox; Ray and Louise St. Louis; Judy and Ken Kennedy; Doreen Williams; and Earl Murphy. They named the club the West Edmonton Promenaders and began dancing in the gym at St Martha's School. The club eventually moved to the Westend Seniors Activity Centre, and finally to the Belmead Community League Hall.

Although most of the founding group had no experience with square dancing, they figured things out with the help of tremendous callers. The first caller couple was Norm and Lorretta Demeule from 1987 to 1989, followed by Henry and Helen Unrau in 1989, and then followed by Gary and Trish (Minns) Winter in 1998. Over the past years, WEP caller couples also included Murray and Barb Few, Lorne and Bernadette Anderson, and Alan and Carola Ellis.

A hallmark event of WEP was the annual 50's Dance. The first WEP 50's night was in March 2002 and it continued for 18 years until March 2020. Everyone had fun dressing up in 50's style and dancing to 50's music. Hotdogs with orange and root beer floats were always on the menu.

WEP was proud to have contributed to our community as well as having a place for people to socialize and benefit from some fun exercise. WEP had an annual Food Bank Dance where food and monetary donations were collected, and the annual Toy Dance to benefit WIN House, the charity who has given women and children of all ages and cultures a safe place to flee from domestic violence for nearly five decades.
