and play music on her lap guitar (Dobro) and spent many years enjoying dancing.

Beryl made friends easily and dancing was a wonderful way to socialize and meet people. In about the year 2000 she was on the dance floor 4-5 times a week either square dancing (Country Sunshiners), round dancing (Kensington Strollers) or at social dances.

In 2008, while playing music at a jam session, she met Peter Guzak. They were married in 2011 and together, they continued to play music with friends and family which always brought her great joy.

A celebration of life took place on Saturday, April 30, 2022. Memorial donations in Beryl's name may be made to the Alberta Cancer Foundation.







CHARLES AND ROSE DALTON

Charlie and Rose Dalton served on the EDSDA board (now known as CDCDA) for more than 6 years. During that time their position of Promenader Editor Couple brought the Promenader from print only to an on-line and print magazine that became accessible to everyone in the square dance community. Their crusade to move the magazine to an on-line version, contributed and motivated the CDCDA board to pursue further developments towards growing the on-line presence of square dancing, clogging, choreographed ballroom, line dancing, and contra. With the knowledge and dedication of Charlie and Rose's passionate efforts, the Promenader Magazine, in print, on-line and the CDCDA website has become a highly considered reference point for all our dance community in Zone 3.

The creation of the Promenader on-line format which is considered to be one of our most popular communication methods to promote activities in Zone 3 and surrounding area is due to the hard work that Charlie & Rose did to ensure that the information was presented in a readable and informative manner. The Promenader magazine has continued to be embraced by the Zone 3 member clubs with the online version being widely accessed.

The Daltons also spearheaded the movement to recognize Hope Pennock who received the AWARD OF EXCELLENCE from the Canadian Square and Round Dance Society for bringing the dance form known as Clogging to Western Canada. We have several clubs who enjoy this form of dance that does not require a partner. In fact, several square dancers who no longer dance for a variety of reasons now Clog for recreation and fitness.

- Mentored and privately tutored many callers
- Caller Reps to clubs and committee members
- Called for various clubs up to six times per week
- Called & entertained at many community square dance demos & campouts

- Attended & called at numerous Provincial & Canadian Conventions
- 2015 CSRDS Long Service Award Recipients
- Instrumental in many club start-ups in various locations
- Called & Cued weekly for free travelling over 2 hours each day for 5 years to prevent a club from folding

As you can see, Bob & Ethel Fyfe have gone over and beyond what is normally expected of square dancers. Their greatest accomplishments are their ability to share their love for square dancing revitalizing and inspiring others to try it.

We believe that they are very deserving and worthy of this prestigious award.


