PRESIDENTS REPORT



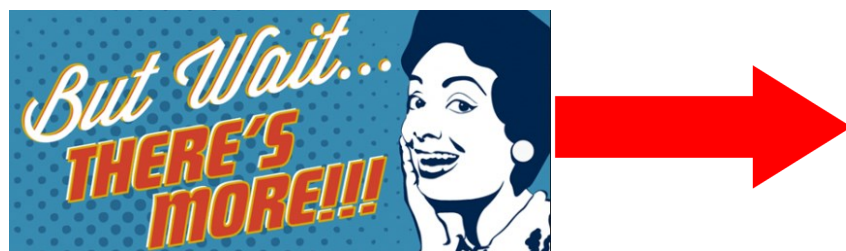

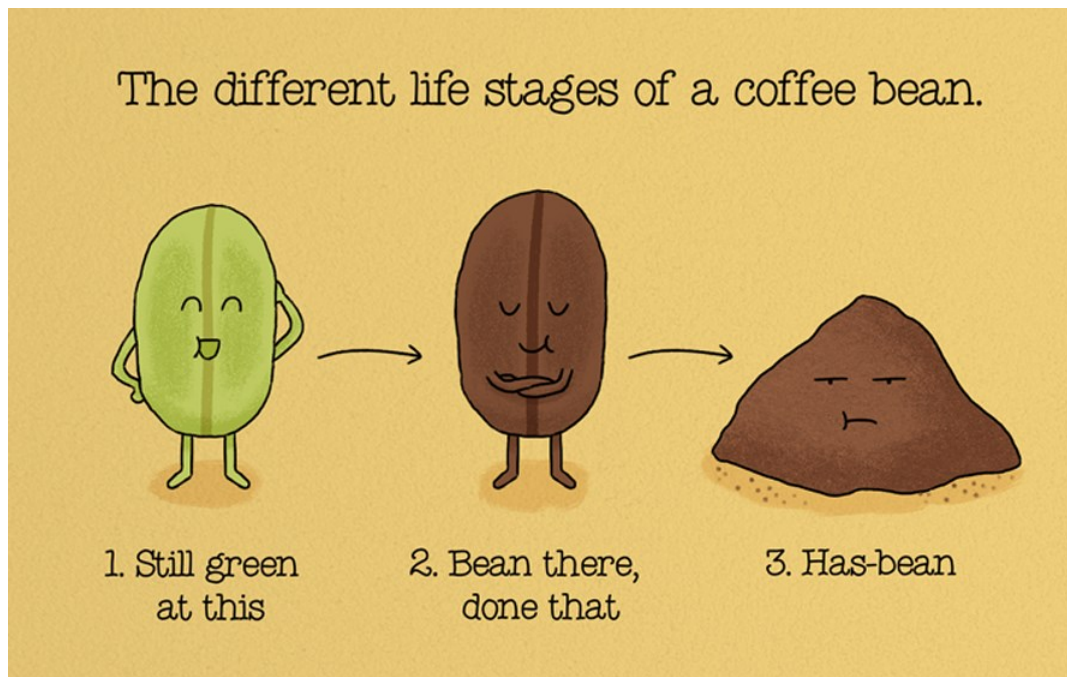


Edmonton Singles

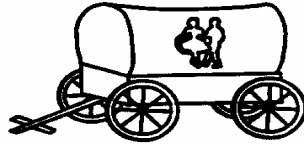

We have been fortunate to have visitors each night. The additional dancers have made it possible for our club to dance.

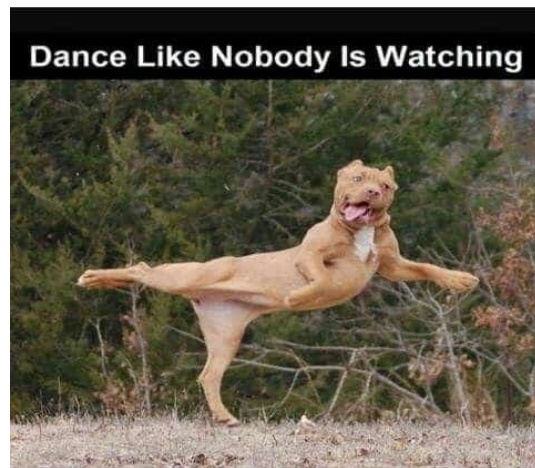

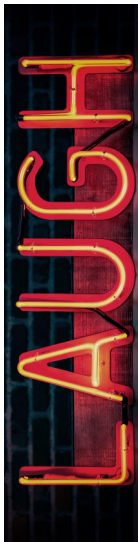
