IN MEMORIAM



Gloria Paquette



Gloria Paquette of Barrhead, AB, passed away peacefully on August 20, 2023 at the age of 91. Born April 29, 1932 in Unity, SK to Lawrence and Pearl (Kay) Humble, Gloria married Albert Paquette on August 17, 1949 in Linaria, AB. They were married for 65 years before Albert's earlier passing in 2015. Gloria will forever be remembered for her wonderful cooking, love of gardening and painting, pride of family, and community volunteerism in Highridge and Barrhead. Gloria's strong personality, love of family, and commitment to friends and neighbours made her a stead-fast anchor both to her family and community. I spoke with an old dancer who had danced with Abe and Gloria for many years. Abe and Gloria have been dancing since the 1960's. They have danced in Fort Assiniboine,Meadowview,Garden View,Hazel Bluff, Westlock, and Edmonton. They took round dance classes by a professional back in the day who stressed body form. These two never moved up and down at all. If there was a string around the hall at a set height, the space between the top of their heads and the string wouldn't change. It was poetry in motion. They attended many different campouts. They ended their dancing when the Cherhill chainers shut down. Callers would include Ivan Shepe , Andy Pennock, Emil Paquette and Bob Weller. I'm sure there were others although we don't know who they were.






